

Call For Contributors

Following the success publication and reception of "Diplomats at War: The British and Commonwealth Experience"(Martin Nijhoff, 2008), Dr Andrew Stewart and Dr J Simon Rofe are seeking contributors to a volume addressing the experience of diplomatic envoys in or from the Americas during times of conflict. The work considers an envoy in broad terms so they may be a Presidential or Prime Ministerial 'Special Representative', a member of the government, opposition or NGO, or a member of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, an Ambassadors or other embassy official. The important criteria is that they were influential in determining events while either the nation they were representing or the one in which they were posted was at war. The work focuses upon envoys during the twentieth century though the cases of others from beyond this timeframe may be considered. Further we would seek to include a range of scholars and those who may currently be located beyond the 'Atlantic World'. We envisage twelve chapters of up to 7500 words
